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Authority Housing Fund (LAHF) grant, to facilitate the purchase of 4 properties to temporarily accommodate Afghan settlement programme refugees in the district and a further property which can be used to accommodate other homeless households. The Council is required to submit a non-binding memorandum of understanding to the Government by early August to confirm if it wishes to take part in the programme.

## 4. Biggins Wood - Update on progress with remediation contract and site disposals (Pages 9 - 52)

The report provides an update to Members regarding the current position of the Biggins Wood site. Following the last Cabinet report in November 2021 (C/21/51) the report updates on the progress of the remediation contract and the sale of the commercial and housing land as previously agreed. The purchaser of the residential land has withdrawn their offer for the site. The commercial developer has made an offer for the whole site (i.e. both elements of commercial and residential land) and a further offer has been received by the council from a different organisation for the residential element of the site only.
