Home Taproom is the official taproom for The Brewery of Angels and Demons, established in 2015. We are a small taproom, on one floor, with an 70 people capacity. We have a small kitchen, in which we host different pop-up kitchens. We are a popular venue with local residents on Tontine Street, and in the Creative Quarter, and hold a positive relationship with residents near the venue whilst constantly supporting the local community, working with individuals to ensure a positive outcome for all. We are looking to extend the hours of our license, to allow for later hours of service. We would like to apply for our license to begin at 11am, and to end at midnight on weekdays, and 1am on weekends. Additionally, we would also like to apply for live, amplified, and recorded music. Currently we hold a license between the hours of midday and 11pm, and midday to 9pm on Sundays. We constantly uphold values and behaviours that promote the licensing objectives, and in turn the safety of our customers, and have successfully acted within the terms of our current license at all times. We would also like to apply for an 'off-sale' license, in which alcohol will be allowed to be sold with the intention of taking/drinking off the premises. This would be an asset to our Taproom, as we have introduced the sale of food through our pop-up restaurants, which is also available for take-away, so we would like to allow the option to take alcoholic drinks with these orders to drink in their homes. Furthermore, we have a drinks fridge that holds many hand-picked beers, which many customers would like to take home with them to drink on a later date, in their homes.

Access to children is restricted during busier periods, and constantly operate a 'Think 25' policy, whereby we ask for official ID for anyone that looks like they may be younger than 25. All children must be supervised by an adult at all times.

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

Our venue is constantly promoting the four licensing objectives, and the values that they promote. We ensure effective and responsible management, coupled with constantly updated training and supervision of staff. We also play an active role in the Folkestone PubWatch scheme, and are active members of the group.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

All licensing conditions will be strictly followed at all times, ensuring the risk of crime and disorder will be limited to a minimum at all times. Any criminal offences that may be committed on or near the premises, despite our best efforts, will be reported to the relevant authorities immediately.

c) Public safety

Our venue takes public safety very seriously. We constantly monitor our capacity to ensure the safety of both our guests and the public. Our bar staff are trained in monitoring and diffusing violent behaviour. The manager of the venue is First Aid trained, and appropriate action will be taken if/when any physical accidents happen. All accidents are recorded in our log book. If there is any concern about the a customer taking alcohol of the premises, this request will not be granted to the customer, in the eyes of public safety when not at the venue.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Sale of alcohol will be controlled, to ensure guests safety, and the safety of the public once they have left the building. Alcohol will be restricted to those who are thought to have had too much, to ensure we are not promoting, and are controlling, anti-social behaviour. Noise will be limited to an acceptable level, as is currently enforced, being aware of our local residents. Litter is constantly cleared both in, and around, the venue, whilst smoking is limited to our smoking area, which has ample ash trays. Our bins are located at the back of the venue.

e) The protection of children from harm

Think 25 policy is operated at all times during the sale of alcohol, to ensure those under 18 do not have access to alcohol. Children are not able to enter the bar after 8 o'clock, however this may be amended to an earlier time on busier nights, controlled by the license holder or representatives, to ensure the safety of children that may enter the premises. Children that enter the premises must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
