## **Annex 1- Mandatory Conditions**

### **Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol**

- (1) Where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions.
- (2) The first condition is that no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (3) The second condition is that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

### **Off Sales**

- On Sundays, other than Christmas Day, 10 a.m. to 10.30 p.m.
- On Christmas Day, 12 noon to 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 10.30 p.m.
- On Good Friday, 8 a.m. to 10.30 p.m.

## **Annex 2 - Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule**

General - to meet all objectives

For restaurant and bar lounge area until 23:30 at Christmas, Good Friday and Sundays with no break on Christmas Day and 24:00 on other days.

For area habitually set apart for meals and entertainment extension Friday and Saturday nights to 01:00.

occupancy/special conditions

Maximum Occupancy Figures: 100 people

Standard Conditions regarding entertainment made by the Council under Schedule 1 Paragraph 11(1) Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982

- Public Entertainment events are permitted for a maximum of 2 events per week for a duration of 4 hours per event. Up to a maximum of 10 events per year are also to be permitted for Bank Holidays, etc.
- External speakers are not to be used.
- All doors and windows are to remain closed during the period that the entertainment is taking place.
- Noise from music or patrons must not be audible within nearby residential premises.
