SUBJECT: ROMNEY MARSH BUSINESS HUB GRANT SCHEME

SUMMARY:

This report sets out applications recommended for approval for the Romney Marsh Business Hub Grant scheme and seeks confirmation for the grant award.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION:

The Leader is asked to agree to the recommendations of the Decision Panel on grant awards, as set out below, because agreement is needed on these applications to the Romney Marsh Business Hub Grant scheme.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. To receive and note Report C/22/29
- 2. To approve the recommended grant applications to the Romney Marsh Business Hub grant scheme as summarised this report.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The Cabinet of Folkestone & Hythe District Council approved the mechanism for establishing and managing the Romney Marsh Business Hub Grant Scheme in July 2021 (C/21/23). The funding for this scheme has been secured from remaining Marsh Million funds which was originally established from financial contributions from Magnox/NDA, KCC, Ashford Borough Council and Folkestone & Hythe District Council.
- 2. THE ROMNEY MARSH BUSINESS GRANT (RMBG) SCHEME
- 2.1 The aim of the Romney Marsh Business Hub Grant Scheme is to provide financial support for businesses who lease an office at the Romney Marsh Business Hub.
- 2.2 The RMBG scheme provides non-repayable grants of up to £10,000 and can cover up to 100% of the costs for the items. However, where a tenant vacates the RMBH within 1 year of receipt of the grant, they may be required to pay `back a proportion of the grant or forfeit assets acquired, on a proportionate basis, depending on the circumstances.
- 2.3 Any organisation signing a lease at the Romney Marsh Business Hub will be eligible to apply for a grant from this scheme.
- 2.4 The grant funding through the scheme can be used for the following:
 - To meet fit out costs for a bespoke design tailored to business needs.
 - To acquire new furniture, office accessories and ICT equipment
 - To off-set up to a maximum of 3 months rent and/or business rates (if payable) for a maximum of 12 months.
- 2.5 The grant scheme was launched in September 2021 and grant applications will be accepted at any time until the closure of the scheme. The scheme is expected to run until either 31st August 2022 or until funds have been allocated.
- 2.6 Applications received are assessed in the first instance by the Economic Development Team, with decisions on individual applications made by the Decision Panel comprising the Lead Cabinet Member for the District Economy, a Councillor from the relevant high street ward, member/s of the Romney Marsh Partnership and a representative from Magnox.
