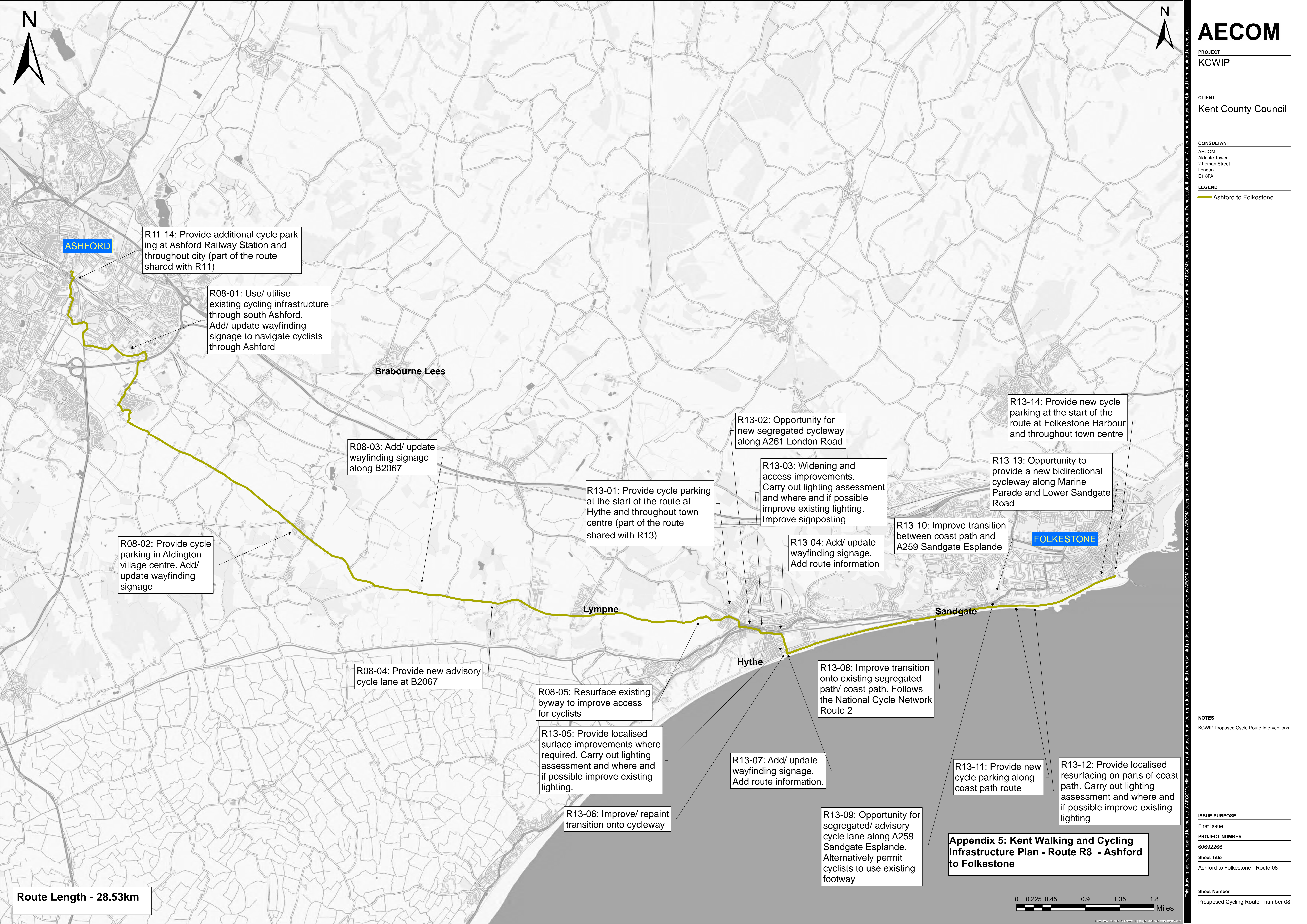




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ASHFORD

R11-14: Provide additional cycle parking at Ashford Railway Station and throughout city (part of the route shared with R11)

R08-01: Use/ utilise existing cycling infrastructure through south Ashford. Add/ update wayfinding signage to navigate cyclists through Ashford

R08-03: Add/ update wayfinding signage along B2067

R08-02: Provide cycle parking in Aldington village centre. Add/ update wayfinding signage

R13-01: Provide cycle parking at the start of the route at Hythe and throughout town centre (part of the route shared with R13)

R13-02: Opportunity for new segregated cycleway along A261 London Road

R13-03: Widening and access improvements. Carry out lighting assessment and where and if possible improve existing lighting. Improve signposting

R13-14: Provide new cycle parking at the start of the route at Folkestone Harbour and throughout town centre

R13-13: Opportunity to provide a new bidirectional cycleway along Marine Parade and Lower Sandgate Road

R13-10: Improve transition between coast path and A259 Sandgate Esplanade

FOLKESTONE

R13-04: Add/ update wayfinding signage. Add route information

Lympne

R08-04: Provide new advisory cycle lane at B2067

R08-05: Resurface existing byway to improve access for cyclists

R13-08: Improve transition onto existing segregated path/ coast path. Follows the National Cycle Network Route 2

Sandgate

R13-05: Provide localised surface improvements where required. Carry out lighting assessment and where and if possible improve existing lighting.

R13-07: Add/ update wayfinding signage. Add route information.

R13-11: Provide new cycle parking along coast path route

R13-12: Provide localised resurfacing on parts of coast path. Carry out lighting assessment and where and if possible improve existing lighting

R13-06: Improve/ repaint transition onto cycleway

R13-09: Opportunity for segregated/ advisory cycle lane along A259 Sandgate Esplanade. Alternatively permit cyclists to use existing footway
