
4 INSTRUCTIONS

On 1 March 2011 Ms Louise Barton, of the Lydd Airport Action Group (LAAG), asked me to provide a short note explaining and linking together the various statements of evidence that I have submitted to the Inquiry.

6 EXPLANATION

- Overall, my evidence relates to nuclear safety issues arising from the juxtaposition of Lydd Airport and its proposed commercial air traffic operation, and the nuclear power station complex of Dungeness, comprising Dungeness A and B nuclear power plants (NPP), and the spent fuel handling operations at the remote railhead located on the Denge.
- 8 Essentially, there are two strands to my evidence:
- 9 i) **Risk and Hazards**: including my disagreement with the Health and Safety Executive's Nuclear Installations Inspectorate assessment that aircraft crash directly onto the NPPs or remote railhead is an acceptable risk and that the radiological consequences would be tolerable; and
- ii) **Site Characteristics**: that the expansion of commercial aircraft operations at Lydd airport requires a re-evaluation in accord with the Government's Demographic Siting Criteria.
- The two strands and how my evidence statements form into these are represented by the following diagrams:
