# Kent economic indicators update 2010

# ECN07-10 September 2010

This paper presents the latest update to the "basket of economic indicators", which are now updated to 2010.

The analysis uses two models; one at County level, the other at District level.

The County-level model summarises a range of indicators for all 149 County and Unitary Authorities in England, ranks the indicators and then converts the ranks to percent-ranks (a rank score out of 100). This standardises all the scores and enables direct comparison of what are very disparate indicator values.

The District-level model does the same for the 354 District and unitary Authorities in England. In the District-level model, two indicators have been changed slightly to reflect the scale of the local economy; total employees and the stock of VAT registered businesses, rather than employee change (since 1998) and net VAT registrations as a percentage of stock, which are used at County level.

In ranking the indicators, the order in which they are ranked has been set so that the higher the score the "better" the outcome. So, for example the earnings indicators are ranked in ascending order where the highest earnings (good) have a percent rank score of 100. In the case of unemployment however, the indicators are ranked in descending order, so that the lowest unemployment rates (good) have a percent rank score of 100. In short; the nearer the outside of the spider chart, or the closer to 100 the percent rank score is, the better.

In both models, the resulting spider chart therefore literally shows the "shape" of the economy of each area, based on these indicators. The 2010 charts are presented here.

The analysis also identifies each area's nearest economic neighbour, based on these indicators. In the last eight years, Essex has been Kent's nearest economic neighbour seven times, and is so again in 2010. Lancashire was Kent's nearest neighbour in 2006.

Recent changes to some of the data sets have meant some inconsistencies in the time-series but this does not really affect the comparison analysis with each area's economic "nearest neighbour". This comparison is helpful in identifying areas with a similar ranking score on each indicator.

There have been a number of significant changes to the economic indicators used in the spider charts which monitor Kent Prospects and the KCC Regeneration Strategy. This note provides the detail of those changes.



# **District-level monitoring**

#### **3 Year Survival Rates**

New 2008 release of the 3-year Survival Rate data has been incorporated into the spider charts. This is taken from the Business demography dataset and counts firms starting in 2005 and surviving through to 2008.

#### **Count of Business Stock**

The count of business stock is also based on the Business demography dataset, with the latest data being for 2008. Historic data has also been updated back to the 2004, to extend the time-series available.

For this reason it is recommended that the 2006 spider chart be used as the new "baseline" date, as this is the first period on the current basis that is consistent with all later dates.

### GVA

The Office for National Statistics has released new data for 2007 while revising the estimates of GVA and GVA per head back to 2004.

#### Workplace and Resident Based Earnings

Earnings data for 2009 has been released and revisions have been made to historic data, affecting both Workplace and Resident-based Earnings. These revisions appear to be small adjustments rather than significant changes and only seem to affect some areas.

#### **Employee Data**

With the release of the 2008 Annual Business Inquiry data, came revised 2007 and 2006 figures. This affects the indicator values for Total Employees and Percentage of Employees in the Knowledge Economy.

The remaining indicators; the **Unemployment Rate**, the **Employment rate** and the **Percentage of those with NVQ4+** have been updated to incorporate the latest data releases and are consistent with previously published figures.

#### Publication dates/survey dates

The spider charts are published on the basis of what is available at the beginning of each year. The spider chart for 2010 therefore shows the latest data that is available for each of the indicators. Some datasets lag behind others in terms of their release date compared to their actual survey date. The following table sets out the actual survey dates for each dataset that are used in each spider chart published.

# **County-level monitoring**

The above comments also apply to the County-level monitoring, however, there are two indicators at County level that differ from those used at district-level and they are both affected by changes.

The county-level spider chart now uses **Net new businesses as a percentage of stock**, based on the new Business Demography dataset. Historic data has been updated back to 2004 (as shown in the 2006 spider chart).

Instead of using the count of total employees, the county-level analysis uses **Employee change since 1998.** This indicator is based on figures from the Annual Business Inquiry, so it has been updated to include data for 2008. Figures for 2007 and 2006 have also been revised.

## **Tables and charts**

The following pages show time-series tables of the rank scores and indicator values, plus a chart showing the shape of the local economy and its nearest neighbour, for the KCC Area, each of the Kent districts and Medway.

A rank of 1 is the lowest (worse) and a rank of 100 is the highest (best).

In the 2010 analysis, it is interesting to note that several Kent Districts now match with one another in terms of their nearest neighbours. Gravesham's nearest neighbour is now Dover, whilst Dover's nearest neighbour is now Shepway. Both Shepway and Thanet's nearest neighbour is Wyre Forest, in Worcestershire. Sevenoaks and Tunbridge Wells also match – in both directions – as nearest neighbours.

Two of Kent's districts have nearest neighbours in Essex; Maidstone's nearest neighbour is Chelmsford and Swale's nearest neighbour is Thurrock.

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


