Subject: DUNGENESS: PROPOSED EXPANSION OF LYDD AIRPORT REQUEST FOR INFORMATION – FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Large & Associates are instructed by the Lydd Airport Action to advise on a matter relating to forthcoming Planning Inquiry on the proposed development of Lydd Airport (London Ashford International Airport - LAIA) – <u>Ms Louise Barton</u> will confirm our instructions - our ongoing and further involvement in this matter is available at the L&A project web page <u>CZ3136</u>.

I refer you to the letters of <u>28 November 2007</u> and <u>17 December 2007</u> from the Nuclear Installations Inspectorate (NII) to Shepway DC providing information relating to the NII's review of the proposed changes in commercial operations at Lydd Airport. I also refer to the <u>Government Circular 04/00</u>, particularly paragraphs A12 to A18 relating to the requirement for consultation with the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) on proposed developments in the vicinity of a hazardous installation, such as the relationship between the proposed development of LAIA in respect to the Dungeness A and B nuclear power plants.

Please provide me with a copy of the following:

- 1) any notification made by Shepway DC to the HSE of the changes to proposed air traffic operations arising from the development of LAIA;
- 2) the notification received from the HSE to Shepway DC identifying the relevant 'consultation zones' relating to
 - a) Dungeness A,
 - b) Dungeness B),
 - c) the railhead spent fuel loading terminal located on the Denge,
 - d) road routes to and from the nuclear plants to the spent fuel loading railhead, and
 - e) rail route from the railhead passing in close proximity to southernmost runway end of LAIA;
 - 3) the 'consultation' zones so identified and advised by the HSE; and
 - 4) any advice and/or notification received from the HSE on the types of developments on which it should be consulted.

I also ask if the

5) HSE made available to Shepway DC or, indeed, if Shepway DC itself commissioned, the results of any Demographic Siting Criteria (DSC), sometimes referred to as the *Hansard* Siting Criteria, relating to the i) the existing nuclear plants (A and B, railhead etc) and the then proposed ii) Dungeness C new build nuclear power plant.

Please note that this request if made under the *Freedom of Information Act 2000* (FOIA) and that you are required, in accord with S10 to respond '*promptly*' and in any event not later than 20 working days – so that there is no misunderstanding on this, the date of the request being submitted is 13 January 2011.
